Objective

In the Paris climate agreement, all countries committed to submit their Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) every 5 years to the United Nations' climate change secretariat. The workshop aims to leave participants with a good understanding of how to design ambitious yet achievable climate strategies in the transport sector, including steps towards implementation of climate actions – and link them to their NDCs and long-term decarbonisation targets. Workshop participants will discuss the hypothesis that sectoral climate targets are an effective vehicle for ambitious climate action in the sector, to ensure target achievement and to help accessing climate finance. Robust transport data are a prerequisite for designing suitable targets and efficient transport systems. The focus is on: How to develop targets? How to identify measures? How to mainstream them into sector plans and policies?

Key Questions

- ✓ How is transport represented in NDCs?
- ✓ What's the contribution of transport to achieve climate targets (role of sector targets)?
- ✓ What are lessons learned on sectoral target setting and sector strategy development in other countries?
- ✓ How to identify the most effective and feasible mitigation actions?
- ✓ How to move from planning to implementation?
- ✓ Where to get guidance and training (esp. on accounting emissions)?
